

TOLLISON 2010 rules

1. They want the bats checked prior to every game. This was mentioned by multiple coaches.
2. A line drive into the pitcher (without hitting the ground, glove etc) it is a dead ball and the batter is out. The bat stays in the game but the park reserves to take the bat if they want to.
3. With co-ed they are still using the senior safety bag at home. If there is a runner going home from third and there is no play at home then the runner is permitted to go to the normal home plate. If there is a runner going home from third and there is a play at home and the runner goes to the normal home plate and strides into the catcher they are out.
4. If the time has expired or 7 innings are finished and the score is tied they are using one pitch.
5. For the Men's and Co-ed they are allowing courtesy runners for an injury 1 time in that inning. In the co-ed if a female needs a runner it is the last female she made an out. And a man for a man.
